Planning a vegetable garden in Buckeye, Arizona

Buckeye 2nd Ward Elders Quorum

- 1. Decide if you are willing to take on this commitment of a garden. It's work.
 - a. Preferably this will be a family affair and you can get every member of your family involved so this does not take you away from your family time, but adds value to family time.
 - b. If you have animals, you will need to make some adjustments to your current use of your yard.
- 2. Plan your garden
 - a. When deciding a location, consider sun exposure and wind exposure.
 - b. In ground or raised bed garden
 - c. What will you grow and where will it be exactly in your garden (draw it out)
 - d. Where to buy your seeds and transplants.
 - e. When do you need to sow seeds or transplant?
 - f. Water supply and application (automatic systems are good, but still require attention to detail. A manual watering system can be used, but requires more diligence by the gardener)
- 3. Build your garden
 - a. Soil type and testing
 - b. Raised bed: build your walls at least 8 inches high, fill with a good soil mix.
 - c. In-ground: Remove existing plants and weeds and till the ground to 12 inches.
 - d. Build your irrigation system (This is one of the most important parts of your garden)
 - e. Start seeds in seed starting trays, other small containers, or directly in the garden area.
 - f. Transplant starter plants into the garden.
- 4. Irrigation implementation
 - a. Different parts of your garden may have different irrigation requirements (seeds, transplants, sun exposure, top mulch, etc.)
 - b. Set watering schedule based on the weather, your plants water requirements, your soil type, your daily inspections of your babies, etc
- 5. Dealing with Pests (both weeds and insects, animals, etc.)
- 6. Dealing with plant diseases
- 7. Harvesting
